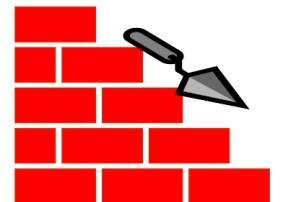

HOME OWNER REHABILITATION PROGRAM

The City of Haslet is gauging interest in the Tarrant County Home Owner Rehabilitation program. This program offers housing repairs and rehabilitation for City of Haslet residents with income that falls below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI) limit. Types of eligible repairs include foundation, roof, plumbing, electrical, and weatherization.

HOME OWNER REHABILITATION PROGRAM



To be eligible to participate in this program you must meet the following qualifications:

- have an annual income below the HUD established income limits (see chart below);
- own your home (place of residence for at least one year);
- have no more than two liens placed against the property;
- must meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - person with disabilities, 62 years of age or older, or family with dependent children living at home (under the age of 18).

TAX PREPARATION ASSISTANCE

The American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax Consulting for the Elderly (TCE) offer free tax help to people who qualify (make generally \$55,000 per year or less).

Tax counselors will answer your questions and also assist with the preparation of your 2018 tax forms utilizing IRS-approved, professional computer programs.
