KEEP ITEMS SEPARATED to make drop off easy. Trash, brush & household hazardous waste (HHW) are dropped off at different stations.

DO NOT mix HHW items. **BRING** HHW items in original containers.

Republic Services will provide onsite dumpsters for trash & brush.

Mobile Shred-It will provide document shredding.

Innovative Electronics Recycling will collect unwanted electronics.
