A Message From Haslet Mayor Bob Golden (March 24, 2020)

The Coronavirus (COVID-19) is continuing to spread throughout the country, in Texas, and even close to home. Part of the spike in reported cases is due to the increase in the number of tests available (more accurate data) and those numbers will most likely continue to climb.

In an attempt to follow current CDC and Tarrant County Health Department guidelines and recommendations, the Haslet City Council made some very difficult but necessary decisions. All City sponsored activities are cancelled through the end of May. This includes, among other things, the annual Easter Egg Hunt, the Wild West Fest, and the Memorial Day Celebration. The City Council will keep its scheduled meetings on the calendar and meet on an as needed basis. Other Board and Commission meetings are postponed until later dates to be announced.

All City buildings are closed to the public while staff remains available via phone and e-mail. Please try to conduct your business by phone, online via the city's website at WWW.HASLET.ORG, by e-mail (staff email address are listed on the website or use the link "Contact Us" on each department's webpage), or through the US Mail. If you have questions or issues, contact city staff for further direction and resolution.

Today I issued a Declaration of Local Disaster for the City of Haslet. As we are currently following all CDC guidelines and Tarrant County Declarations/ Executive Orders, you should see no change from what has been issued by Tarrant County. We have been lucky up to this point with no positive testing results in Haslet and I am extremely proud of the efforts that all of you have made to follow national, state, and county direction and diligently work to keep all of us safe. Quite frankly, my main purpose in issuing this Declaration was to make the City eligible for reimbursement of funds expended to support our efforts to fight the Coronavirus (COVID-19). At a Special Council Meeting held this evening, your City Council extended the expiration of this Haslet Declaration of Local Disaster to mirror the expiration of the most current Tarrant County Declaration/Executive Order. I do want you to know that your City Council is taking this threat very seriously and your safety is our Number One Priority. Please continue to follow our state, county, and city leadership as we collectively and proactively work to manage the battle with this virus. Keep an eye out for your neighbors and call us at City Hall if you have any questions or concerns. Stay safe.

Tarrant County "Shelter In Place" Declaration of Local Disaster is effective 3/24/20 at 11:59 pm thru April 7th

Restrictions apply to all of Tarrant County including the City of Haslet. The complete declaration can be seen at www.haslet.org. Non-essential workers will stay at home. Trips to purchase food, medications, to seek medical treatment and check on the welfare of elderly or others in need are permitted. A list of many essential and non-essential business operations is on the back of this newsletter. The City of Haslet will continue to monitor the situation and follow Tarrant County Health Department recommendations to determine a date to resume business as usual.
