Blue Mound Road Construction Notification

June 30, 2020

Working through a mutual partnership agreement, Tarrant County, Precinct 3, under the direction of the City of Fort Worth will provide the construction services to repair and resurface Blue Mound Road from US 287 to the Fort Worth City limits near Wagley Robertson Road (3200 feet east of US 287, just west of Lonesome Dove Estates near the gas well distribution site). This project is a cooperative effort to repair and improve the current pavement condition of Blue Mound Road. This maintenance project will rehabilitate the roadway in its present configuration with no additional width or turn lanes added.

Construction is scheduled to begin Thursday, July 9th. Roadway construction work hours will be between 8:15 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday and project should complete by Friday, July 31th.

Thursday, July 9 – Friday, July 10: The first phase of work will be to remove 4 inches of the existing roadway material. This work will be completed by a milling contractor to prepare the roadway for stabilization and resurfacing. During this phase, traffic on Blue Mound Road will be reduced to one lane in the areas being removed. Flaggers will direct traffic one direction at a time through the construction area. **EXPECT 10 – 15 MIN DELAYS.** All roadways will be re-opened after 4 pm. Access for emergency services will be available at all times.

Monday, July 13 – Friday, July 31: The second phase of work will be to recycle and stabilize the existing road base materials and place the new asphalt surface. During this phase, **BLUE MOUND ROAD WILL BE CLOSED AT GRAY DOVE LANE TO ALL WESTBOUND TRAFFIC, Monday – Friday from 8:15 am to 4 pm.** All traffic between US 287 to Gray Dove Lane will be Eastbound ONLY, toward FM 156. **All traffic exiting the neighborhoods and businesses between US 287 and FM 156 MUST DETOUR East to FM 156.** No one will be allowed to turn or continue west toward US 287 past Gray Dove Lane. At times, various side streets and driveways entering Blue Mound Road may be temporarily inaccessible while the operations are directly in front of the access point. If possible, please use other routes to enter/exit; access will be restored as quickly as possible. All roadways will be re-opened and traffic restored to normal operations after 4 pm. Access for emergency services will be available at all times.



Typically, we find the first week to be the most challenging until the traffic becomes accustomed to the traffic control measures and/or adjust itself to the alternative routes. Please know that we will be aggressively pursuing completion of this project while attempting to minimize the public's inconvenience as much as possible. During certain times, our operations may limit your access. We will do our best to accommodate you as quickly as possible. **Please use alternative routes (Bonds Ranch Road) when possible and plan on 10 to 15 minute delays if you must travel through the construction area.**

The schedule provided is weather and material delivery pending.

Your safety and the safety of our crews are of the utmost importance. Please be patient, drive slowly through the construction zone and be keenly aware of the large equipment and personnel working to make improvements for you. Plan extra time for delays if you must travel through the construction area or use alternative routes. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to make these improvements.
