CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR EFFORTS COMBATING COVID -19! BUT....

(August 18, 2020) Our best weapon to combat the Coronavirus remains each and every one of you. Our positivity rate in Texas remains way too high but it does appear that your efforts are beginning to create a noticeable change in the right direction. With the start of NISD's Return to Learn Program on August 20th with remote learning and the ability to start In-Person learning on September 14th, it is incumbent on all of us to ensure that our children are healthy every morning before we send them off to school (if that is your choice). Please take precautions at home, especially early and late in the day, to limit your exposure to these pesky critters.


