5. Tract 6B, out of the Henry Robertson Survey Abstract 1259 Tarrant County, Texas (approximately 19.506 acres); and
6. Tract 6A03 out of the Henry Robertson Survey Abstract 1259 Tarrant County, Texas (approximately 6.146 acres)

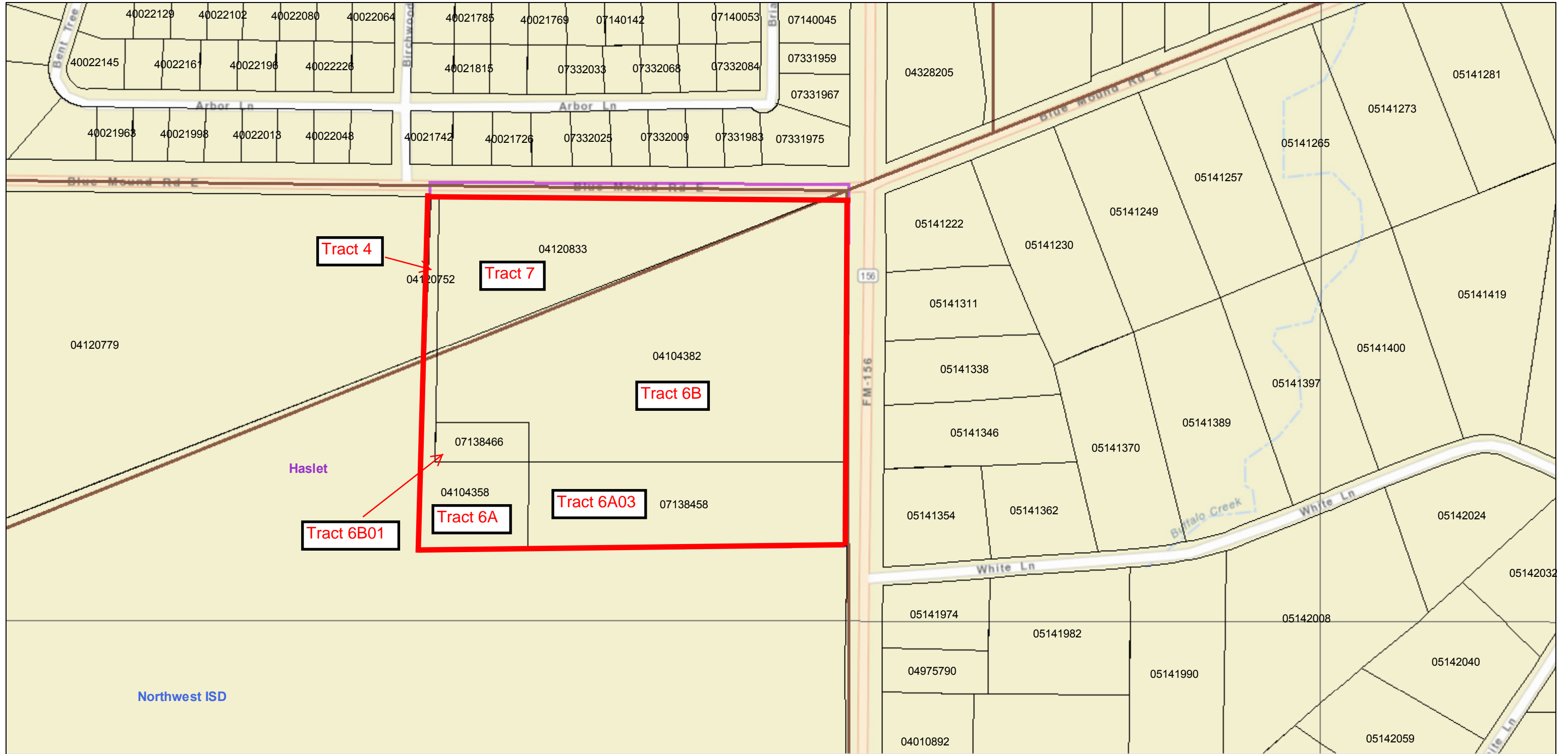

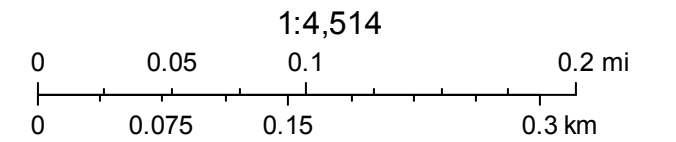
