### GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANCELLED SPECIAL MEASURE ELECTION IS SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2016

The Haslet City Council accepted the Certification of Unopposed Candidates for the May 7, 2016, General Municipal Election at the March 7, 2016, regular city council meeting and approved cancelling the May 7, 2016 General Municipal Election. Council then approved Ordinance 010-2016 declaring the unopposed candidates—Council Member Place 1 - Warren Robb, Council Member Place 3 - Kathy Hopper, and Council Member Place 5 - Harold Williams—as elected to office. These individuals will take the Oath of Office on May 16, 2016. Haslet will still have a Special Measure Election on May 7, 2016 to submit to the voters the combined ballot proposition as follows:

#### “PROPOSITION

*The reduction of the current one half of one percent (0.5%) sales and use tax allocated to the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC - Type A) by one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) and the adoption of a local sales and use tax at a rate of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.”*

Approval of the proposition would allocate funding from sales and use tax that is now collected for the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC—Type A) to be halved between the HEDC—Type A (0.25%) and city street maintenance and road repairs (0.25%). In the event this proposition is not approved, the 0.5% sales and use tax currently allocated to the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC—Type A) will remain unchanged. Early voting will be held at the Haslet Public Library beginning April 25th to May 3rd.
