## Haslet Fall 'Dumpster Day' will be November 7, 2009

**Citizens will also have the ability to get bulk shredding done for free!**

Haslet, Texas, November 5, 2009: Citizens of the City of Haslet, Texas, will participate in Haslet's Fall 'Dumpster Day' on **Saturday, November 7, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. to noon**. This event affords them an opportunity to unload all the results from cleaning both in the home and the yard. New this time, the 'Mobile Shred It' van will be on site to accept up to five boxes of private papers to shred. The mobile unit can shred paper, CDs/DVDs, and credit cards. Hard drives are **not** accepted for shredding.

Dumpster Day is held in the field behind the Fire Station at 1701 Highway 156, in Haslet. To prove residency (this event is only open to Haslet residents) a Haslet water bill will be requested at the gate.

Allowable dumpster items are: furniture, cell phones (without the battery), computer towers (but not the monitors) and any brush and lawn clippings. Paint cans will be accepted only if the lid is off and the paint within is completely dried. Prohibited dumpster items include: tires, refrigerators, televisions or any hazardous material, biohazard/ medical material or household hazardous chemicals (such as pesticides or herbicides).

Citizens are encouraged to participate and there is no limit to number of loads they may bring, but are asked not to bring more than 5 file boxes worth of shredding.
