NEW BUSINESSES COMING TO HASLET

As a result of many months of behind the scenes negotiation, two companies will be making their homes in Haslet's industrial area. City Council, the Haslet Economic Development Corporations Type A and Type B and staff worked for over a year to negotiate favorable tax incentive packages with each of these businesses.

Airborne Tactical Advantage Co. (ATAC), a Textron Company, will be opening an Adversary Center of Excellence facility and will lease 184,000 sq. ft. of an existing facility and also build a new hangar facility of approximately 75,000 sq. ft. ATAC performs maintenance, repairs and overhauls fighter planes and advanced tactical aircraft used to train pilots. The Haslet location will employ up to 200 people. The project is expected to add more than \$100,000,000 to the tax base.

Also coming to Haslet is Composites One, a distributor of composites including raw materials, processing supplies and equipment. Composites One will construct a distribution facility of approximately 60,000 sq. ft. and employ 20 people. The project is expected to add more than \$5,000,000 to the tax base.

COMING TO A STREET SIGN NEAR YOU

HASLET COMMUNITY PARK PAVILLION AND TRAIL LIGHTING

Improvements to the Haslet Community Park are underway thanks to funding by the Haslet Community and Economic Development Corporation Type B. Recently a covering was installed over the existing basketball courts. The original intent of the basketball courts remains, and the new covering will provide a central anchor location for city special events and other activities, as well as shelter from inclement weather and relief from the hot Texas sun. Also planned for the walking trail around Haslet Community Park is the installation of 55 solar-powered lights that will illuminate the entire length of the existing walking trail. The initial investment is expected to have a very positive impact on the park and its usage. The plan is for the lights to be installed this summer.
