## VACANCY FILLED FOR COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 3

At the Regular City Council Meeting held on Monday, August 5, 2019, City Council appointed Ms. Jessica Clarke to fill the vacant Council Member Place 3 position through the end of the term (May 2020). The position was vacant since the end of May due to the resignation of long-time Council Member Kathy Hopper who relocated out of state.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASLET WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING AT A SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2019 AT 6:30 P.M. IN THE HASLET COMMUNITY CENTER, 105 MAIN STREET. THE PURPOSE WILL BE TO HEAR PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF THE PROPOSED CITY OF HASLET OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020. THIS BUDGET WILL RAISE LESS REVENUE FROM PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY AN AMOUNT OF \$93,605, WHICH IS A 3.67% DECREASE FROM LAST YEAR'S BUDGET. THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE RAISED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL THIS YEAR IS \$48,561.
