Re ITB 2020-05 Gammill Park Playground - Addendum 1:

The City of Haslet is publishing this addendum to the Invitation to Bid 2020-05 Gammill Park Playground Equipment

- **The bid due date will be changed to Thursday June 25 at 4:00pm.**
- **Due to COVID-19 restrictions City Hall is not open to the general public. Bids shall be dropped of at City Hall by calling the phone number posted on the front door.**

The following questions have been received:

- What type of safety surfacing – engineered wood fiber is assumed? Should drains be installed? *We would want either Pip (Pour-in-Place Rubber) or Synthetic Turf. Drain as required by the manufacturer.*
- It appears that there is an existing play system within a concrete border with a ramp entry. Should demolition & removal of the existing equipment be included in our bid? Will the new play equipment be installed within the existing concrete border, or will a new border be required? Do you have concrete specifications? *Ideally the new equipment would fit within the existing border. Demolition of existing equipment should be included.*
- Do you have pricing for permits & inspections? *Permits would need to be pulled but at no cost.*
- Should we include pricing to demolish & remove existing fencing? If new fencing is to be installed, do you have specifications for the fencing? *If we keep the existing concrete border we have to work with the fence we have. If a new fence is needed a flat top panel fence made from tubing in black would look more up to date. The existing post could be painted/coated to match or use to anchor the new fence.*
- Are sodding & irrigation required? *No*

- Specs call for a 5-12 play area, but spring riders are for 2-5. Should we plan for a 2-12 play area? *Yes, since the spring riders are on the Park Boards wish list.*
- Any particular color desired for the Poured-In-Place rubber? I assume you want the grass-green for the synthetic turf option. *Park Board requested a nature theme if possible so green or brown.*
- Do you know if there is currently drainage out of the playground area? I would assume so since the EWF is in place but I didn't think to look when I was there. Does the playground area ever have standing water after a hard rain? Just asking since both PIP and Turf will need drainage out of the site. *There is no existing drainage system in the playground. If a drainage system is necessary for the PIP or turf then it will need to be included in the proposal.*
